

All, I have taken a bit of time to explain the concept of the entry changes to ensure that the track league can continue and mitigate the rising costs we all face. One of the challenges is ensuring that we have a minimum number of riders to break even, also we have specific time frames to ensure we get the paper work ready for the race.

The cost to enter the track league has been increased a small amount, this is to mitigate the increased costs of track hire and running costs.

The changes will reward the early entry and is designed to change behaviours of pre entry.

Youth, Junior and Sprinters	£14	£16	£20
Senior and Masters groups	£15	£17	£20

So to avoid paying any extra late entry fees please enter in advance of any cost increases

Most of the British Cycling Track leagues are around £12.50 to £15.00 so the cost to enter on time is competitive also half of those leagues are outdoor leagues.

If you are still reading the costs can go down if rider numbers increase enough or we find a sponsor, that pays enough to allow this to happen.
